Through our leadership and alliances, the **Metro Multifamily Housing Association Government & Public Affairs Team** works diligently to prevent erroneous bills from becoming law and, last session, greatly limited the possible scope and impact of passed legislation. We are already hard at work preparing for the 2011 session to ensure equitable Landlord/Tenant laws.

MMHA has formed its own **Political Action Committee** to raise the necessary funds to represent and fight for equitable Landlord/Tenant laws.

We remain committed to **engaging with local jurisdictions** and advising decision and policy makers on property management issues.

Our Executive Director, Deborah Imse, is a commissioner for the Portland Housing Bureau Advisory Commission, and a member of both the Bureau Advisory Committee and Neighborhood Inspections and Stockholders Advisory Committee.

MMHA actively participated in the Bureau of Housing **Section 8 Taskforce** to improve the popular voucher program and raise voucher acceptance levels.
