



POOL MAINTENANCE

All important preventive maintenance, proper chemical storage and updates to current laws will be covered in this class. Pool & spa operators will gain a full understanding of each required chemical and how they each work together. Segments include preventing transmission of diseases, maintaining water and water clarity, avoiding algae and removal of phosphates in both pools and spas.

You will receive a step-by-step, hands-on instructional tutorial on the use of a Taylor water test kit; review of the Oregon Pool and Spa statutes, and the proper storage of chemicals. In addition, you will explore ways in which preventive maintenance can preserve the life of your equipment and can reduce money spent on costly repairs.
